



Brady Vickers

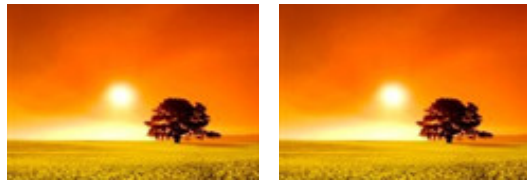
August 9, 1946 - January 6, 2014
