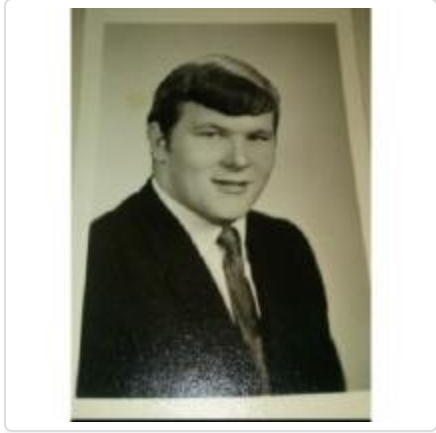




Bruce Lynn Johnson
