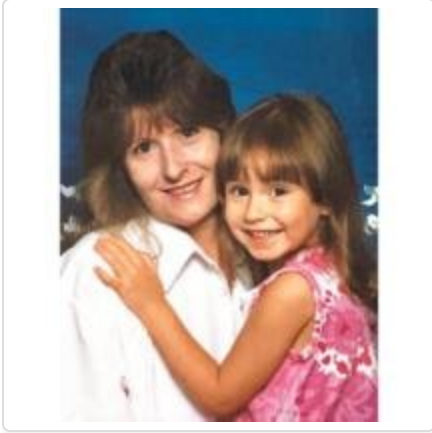




Carol Lynn Smith
