RET. CHIEF MASTER SERGEANT (USAF) CLYDE NOBLE, 81, of South Point, OH, died Thursday, August 14, 2014, in Veterans Administration Medical Center, Huntington, WV. Clyde was born September 20, 1932, in Lawrence County, OH, a son of the late Eph and Addie Lundy Noble. After graduating from South Point High School in 1951, Clyde entered the United States Air Force. For 27 years he served with honor and pride. He traveled the world and received several medals, accommodations, and achievement awards. After retiring, he returned to the place he loved most, HOME. He then drove a bus for South Point Schools before retiring again after 15 years, and he also drove for the CAO Sybene Senior Citizen Center.
