



Edward McKee

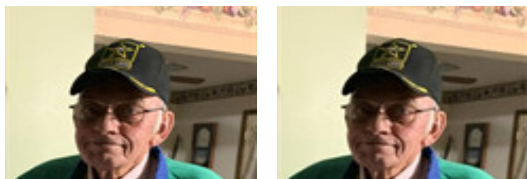
April 18, 1943 - December 21, 2020
