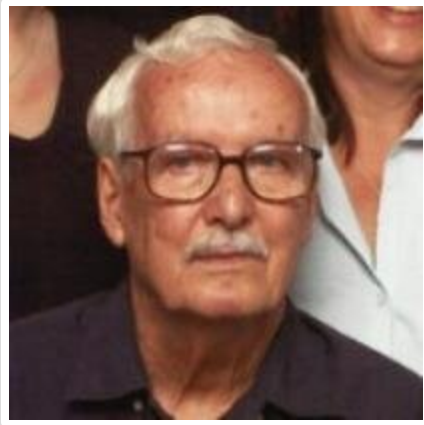




Elton "Wally" Waugh

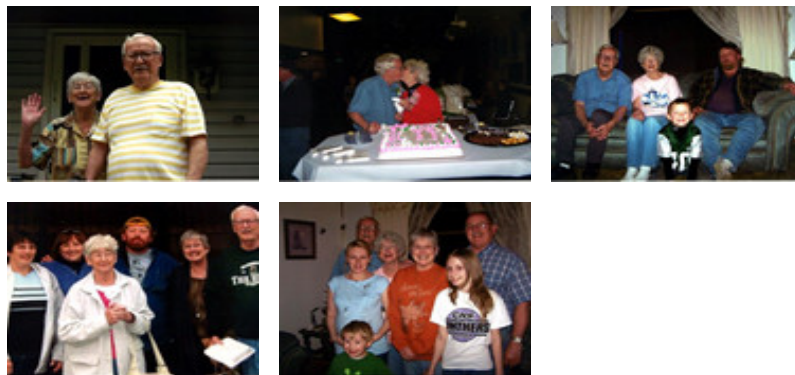
