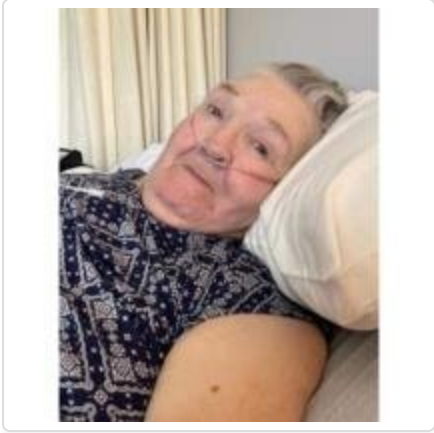




JACQUELINE BOWMAN
