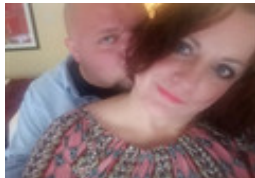
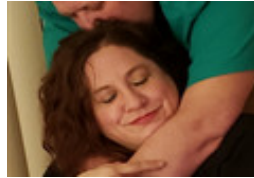
Pallbearers will be Brody Aliff, Richard Terry, Keith Crawford, Chase Williams, Matt Adkins, and Mark Collins.
