



Jonathan James Ratcliff

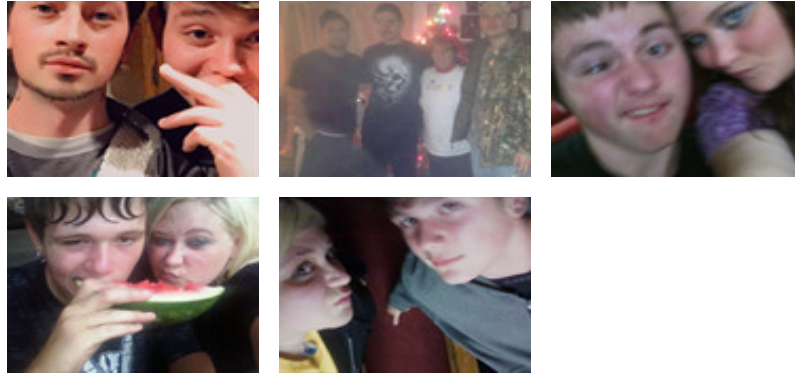
June 26, 1995 - November 25, 2021
