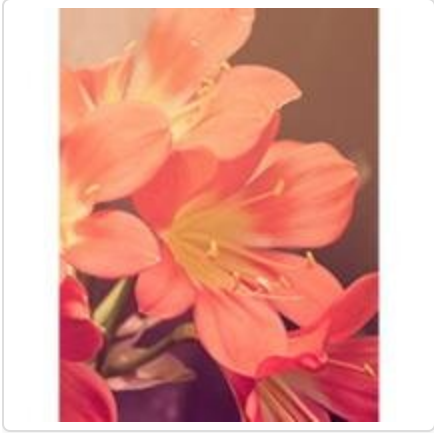




Marilyn Lou Burns
