



Richard Anthony Tyler

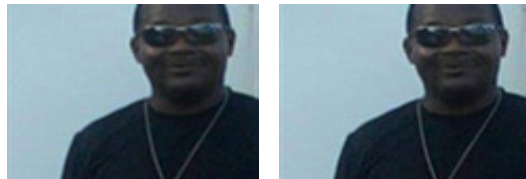
November 28, 1967 - January 27, 2020
